2. **Plainville High School reserves the right to use breathalyzers at any and all school sponsored events, including proms. Students and/or guests believed to be under the influence of alcohol may be tested in accordance with the guidelines outlined in Board Policy #5145.124(a).**
3. Student should bring any belongings that they will need when they enter. Once inside the prom facility, students will need a chaperone/escort to their car. A student who leaves for the night may not return. Students are expected to leave the prom facility grounds in a timely manner.
4. Students are expected to conduct themselves in an appropriate manner during the prom. Inappropriate or disruptive behavior will not be tolerated and may result in a student being asked to leave. If this occurs, parents will be notified.
5. Students who desire to leave before 9:00 pm will have their parents contacted.
6. All prom guests who do not attend PHS need to complete the PHS Prom Guest Form. In addition, on the night of the prom, the guest **MUST** be introduced to a member of PHS administration. (Mr. Medic, Mr. Coe, or Mr. Johnson)
7. The Friday before and the Monday after prom is a normal school day and the attendance policy will be followed.
